We provide clothes, shoes and other essentials for people in great need and run English classes which are well attended and much enjoyed. We get to learn



what life is like for people in many of the troubled home countries they have had to leave behind – including Syria, Afghanistan, Sudan, and Ukraine but also how much we have in common wherever in the world we may come from. The theme for Refugee Week this year is “Community as a Superpower” and there are many ways in which you can support our work locally.
